SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION TO CREATE A PLAN FOR THE KA'Ū HOSPITAL TO INCORPORATE MODERN COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHY EQUIPMENT BY JULY 1, 2024.

WHEREAS, Ka'ū Hospital was built by the State in 1971 and is 1 2 the only hospital in the Ka'ū District in Southern Hawai'i Island, an area approximately the size of Oahu; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, in 1997 when Hawaii Health Systems Corporation (HHSC) was formed, Ka'ū Hospital became one of HHSC's facilities; 6 7 and 8 WHEREAS, in 2001, Ka'ū Hospital achieved critical access 9 hospital status, a federal designation given to small rural 10 hospitals that provide essential emergency and acute services in 11 remote areas to assist them with the financial challenges 12 associated with their size and isolation; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the district of Ka'ū is considered a medically 15 16 underserved area; and 17 WHEREAS, Ka'ū Hospital is the only hospital in the district 18 that provides x-ray services; now, therefore, 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, 22 that HHSC is requested to create a plan for the Ka'ū Hospital to 23 incorporate modern computed tomography equipment by July 1, 24 25 2024; and 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the plan to incorporate modern 27 computed tomography equipment is requested to include: 28 29 A list of appropriate tomography equipment to be (1)30 purchased and installed; 31 32 The estimated total cost of purchase and installation; (2) 33 34 and

6	report of the plan to the Legislature no later than twenty days
7	prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2023; and
