
#### BRIAN FUJIWARA

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Mr. Ishibashi's background, knowledge, and proven leadership on the Board of Professional Engineers, Architects, Surveyors, and Landscape Architects qualify him for reappointment to the Board as a public member. Your Committee notes that Mr. Ishibashi currently works as a Program Specialist V for the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations. Your Committee therefore recommends that Benedict Lee be reappointed to the Board of Professional Engineers, Architects, Surveyors, and Landscape Architects based on his experience, knowledge, and commitment to public service.
