Your Committee reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by Sterling Higa for service on the Hawaii Community Development Authority.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination for the appointment of Sterling Higa from the Hawaii Community Development Authority, Hawaii Laborers & Employers Cooperation and Education Trust Fund, and ten individuals.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Mr. Higa's leadership and desire to serve qualify him for appointment to the Hawaii Community Development Authority as an at-large member, pursuant to section 206E-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Your Committee finds that Mr. Higa was born and raised in Honolulu. He graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in Communicology from the University of Hawaii at Manoa and a Master of Arts in Education from Harvard University. He has over ten years of experience in teaching, with a focus on coaching, public speaking, and writing. Your Committee notes that in 2021, Mr. Higa co-founded Housing Hawaii's Future, a nonprofit aimed at


