Sir:

Your Committee on Health, Human Services, & Homelessness, to which was referred H.B. No. 104 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO POOLS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to define "swimming pool" for the purposes of administrative rule making by the Department of Health.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from Imanaka Asato LLC, five individuals, and a petition with numerous individuals. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from the Department of Health.

Your Committee finds that clarifying that "swimming pools" as impervious, artificial bodies of water for swimming, diving, or recreational bathing or therapy will reduce confusion over oversight by the Department of Health over recreational bodies of water.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing the effective date to July 1, 2060, to encourage further discussion.


As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Health, Human Services, & Homelessness that is
