Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B.
No. 1072, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII
TUITION AND FEES SPECIAL FUND,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to repeal the requirements
established by Act 236, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, which
required:

- (1) Each University of Hawaii campus to prepare an
operations plan to be reviewed by the President, Vice
President for Budget and Finance, and Chief Financial
Officer of the University of Hawaii; and
- (2) Monies in the University of Hawaii Tuition and Fees
Special Fund for each University of Hawaii campus to
lapse to the credit of program identification
number UOH900, University of Hawaii system wide support.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the University of Hawai'i System and one individual.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 1072, H.D. 1, and recommends that it pass Third Reading.
