- (1) Amending the Law Enforcement Officer Independent Review Board to:
 - (A) Require members to serve four-year terms; and
 - (B) Make the board permanent; and
- (2) Amending the membership and powers of the Law Enforcement Standards Board and extending certain members' terms to four years.

Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from the State of Hawaii Organization of Police Officers and one individual. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of the Attorney General, Department of

Your Committee has amended this measure by:


- Changing the effective date to July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion; and
