H.B. No. 1424 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CANDIDATE COMMITTEE AND

The purpose of this measure is to repeal certain cross-  
references in the campaign spending law that refer to language  
that was previously repealed.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure

Your Committee finds that this bill is a housekeeping measure  
that will repeal references to provisions in the Hawaii Revised  
Statutes that were repealed in 2018.

Your Committee has amended this measure by making a  
technical, nonsubstantive amendment for the purposes of clarity,  
consistency, and style.

your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.
