Your Committee on Water & Land, to which was referred H.B. No. 1654 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE DIVISION OF BOATING AND OCEAN RECREATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to authorize the Board of Land and Natural Resources to adopt, amend, or repeal administrative fee schedules for parking fees for locations under management of, or operated by, the Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation through regular or special board meetings rather than through administrative rulemaking.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Land and Natural Resources. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the League of Women Voters of Hawaii.

Your Committee finds that amending fees schedules for parking fees through administrative rulemaking can be a lengthy and timeconsuming process. This measure allows the Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation to react in a timely manner to changing market conditions and unforeseen circumstances.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- Changing the effective date to July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.


