Your Committee on Conference on the disagreeing vote of the House of Representatives to the amendments proposed by the Senate in H.B. No. 2466, H.D. 2, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TARO,"

having met, and after full and free discussion, has agreed to recommend and does recommend to the respective Houses the final passage of this bill in an amended form.

The purpose of this measure is to provide a general excise tax exemption for the gross proceeds or income received from the sale of any product resulting from the cultivation and production of unprocessed taro in the State.

Your Committee on Conference has amended this measure by:

- (1) Making it effective upon its approval; and
- (2) Repealing the measure on June 30, 2027.






