Your Committee on Judiciary & Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 143 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE JUDICIARY TO PARTNER WITH SUPPORTING AGENCIES AND REQUEST GRANT FUNDS UNDER THE VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT TO ESTABLISH AND SUPPORT A RESTORATIVE JUSTICE PROGRAM IN EACH COUNTY TO ALLOW VICTIMS AND OFFENDERS AN OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN RESTORATIVE JUSTICE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to urge the Judiciary to partner with supporting agencies and request grant funds under the Victims of Crime Act to establish and support a restorative justice program in each county to allow victims and offenders an opportunity to participate in restorative justice.




