PRESERVATION OF NATIVE HAWAIIAN ART,"


begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the State
Foundation on Culture and the Arts to provide a report on the
total amount of funding expended from the Works of Art Special
Fund for the curation of art produced by an individual of Native
Hawaiian decent ("Native Hawaiian art"), number of Native Hawaiian
art pieces acquired, percentage of all works collected through the
Works of Art Special Fund that is Native Hawaiian art, cost per
Native Hawaiian art piece acquired, and percentage of the cost of
all works collected through the Works of Art Special Fund
attributed to the cost of acquiring Native Hawaiian art; and
request the Foundation to submit the report to the Legislature no
later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular
Session of 2023.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.R. No. 119 and
recommends its adoption.
