Your Committee on Culture, Arts, & International Affairs, to which was referred H.R. No. 14 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING MARCH 17 AS ST. PATRICK'S DAY IN HONOR OF SAINT PATRICK AND IN RECOGNITION OF THE LONGSTANDING RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN IRELAND AND THE UNITED STATES AND THE NOTEWORTHY CONTRIBUTIONS AND ACHIEVEMENTS OF IRISH-AMERICANS TO OUR NATION,"

The purpose of this measure is to recognize March 17 as St. Patrick's Day in honor of Saint Patrick and in recognition of the longstanding relationship between Ireland and the United States and the noteworthy contributions and achievements of Irish-Americans to the United States.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from one individual. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from the Center for Hawaiian Sovereignty Studies.

Your Committee finds that although St. Patrick's Day began as a religious holiday, in America it has become a celebration of Irish culture and history by peoples of diverse ethnicities and cultures with parades, festivals, traditional Irish music sessions, and other activities that honor and celebrate the life
