Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 1128, S.D. 2, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO OFFICE OF YOUTH SERVICES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Allow certain vocational programs within the Office of Youth Services to engage in the commercial provision of goods and services to promote self-sustainability in young adults;
- (2) Require the Office of Youth Services to submit annual reports to the Legislature on the fiscal transactions and expenses of each service or program of the Office of Youth Services; and
- (3) Require an audit of the Office of Youth Services if the annual fiscal transactions and expenses reports are not submitted in a timely manner.


