Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 2821, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MENSTRUAL EQUALITY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Require the Department of Education and State Public Charter School Commission to provide menstrual products to all students, free of charge, on all public school and public charter school campuses; and
- (2) Appropriate funds to provide the menstrual products.



Your Committee has amended this measure by:


- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2022; and
