Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 3320, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO FERAL PIG CONTROL PERMITS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Explicitly include feral pigs within the Department of Land and Natural Resources' permit system for the destruction within a district of wild birds, game birds, and game mammals; and
- (2) Clarify that the Department of Land and Natural Resources may provide by rule that no permit or report shall be required to destroy or control game mammals, including feral pigs, during daytime hours on privately owned land when the action is otherwise in compliance with departmental rules.


