Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B.  
No. 375, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require the Department of  
Transportation to conduct a study to determine the feasibility of  
repairing or renovating the Kalaeloa Airport air traffic control  
tower.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure  
from the Department of Transportation and Palehua Townhouse  
Association. Your Committee received comments on this measure  
from the Makakilo/Kapolei/Honokai Hale Neighborhood Board No. 34.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Deleting language that would have required the  
Department of Transportation to:
  - (A) Collaborate with the Department of Defense and  
Federal Aviation Administration to conduct a study  
to determine the feasibility of repairing or




renovating the Kalaeloa Airport air traffic control tower; and

- (B) Submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 375, S.D. 2, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Third Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 375, S.D. 2, H.D. 1.
