Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred
S.C.R. No. 193 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION TO DEVELOP A PLAN FOR THE COST-EFFECTIVE
DISPOSITION OF THE SAFE TRAVELS THERMAL SCREENING AND TRACING
CAMERA EQUIPMENT AND OTHER RELATED OPERATIONS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of
Transportation Airports Division to develop a preliminary draft
thermal screening and tracing camera repurpose plan for its five
major airports.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Transportation. Your Committee received
testimony in opposition to this measure from one individual.


Your Committee finds that during the coronavirus disease 2019
pandemic, the State took several measures to ensure the safety of
the State and its residents, including the purchase and use of
thermal screening and tracing camera equipment at the State's five
major airports. Because the thermal screening and tracing camera
equipment maintenance contract will terminate at the end of June
2022, it would be fiscally responsible for the Department of
Transportation Airports Division to find uses for the equipment
for the betterment of the airports and traveling public.
