Your Committee further finds that the Waianae Moku Kupuna Council, which consists of long-time residents of west Oahu who are Hawaiian cultural practitioners sixty years of age or older, is a valuable resource of historical and cultural knowledge about the Waianae Moku community. This measure encourages elected members of the Legislature who represent the Waianae Moku community to consult with the Waianae Moku Kupuna Council on issues that are of importance to the Waianae Moku community.
