Mission Statement

The department's mission statement is to assist authorities in providing for the safety, welfare, and defense of the people of Hawaii. The department will maintain readiness to respond to the needs of the people in the event of disasters, either natural or human-caused; will administer policies and programs related to veterans and families and provide at-risk youth with opportunities to obtain their high school diplomas and become productive citizens.

Economic Impact

The Department of Defense operating budget is comprised of 14 percent General funds and 86 percent Federal funds. In FY 2015, the Department was restricted \$1,713,660 in General funds.

The impact of the reduction of the FY 2015 General fund operating budget base will result in approximately \$5,140,980 (at 75%) of federal funds being left on the table. These funds totaling \$6,440,980 provide the department with funds to execute minor construction projects to maintain and improve the facilities of the Hawaii National Guard, provide the state match for Emergency Management Program Grant funds to sufficiently man the emergency operating center for the State Civil Defense division and also the state match to receive 75% federal funds to help operate the Youth Challenge Academy.

Federal Funds

At this point of time, the department can only speculate what the Federal Government will reduce when they allocate funds to the States. Military construction (MILCON) funds for Federal Fiscal Year 2015, 2016 and 2017 have been approved for funding and awaiting the President's approval of the Military Budget. While MILCON can be postponed should the funding be diverted, of more concern is the continued funding of enough Federal funds to maintain critical operating costs such as utilities, pest control, trash pickup and minor repairs to prevent the closures of any Hawaii National Guard facilities. These facilities are required to keep the Guard in top readiness status.

The situation is the same in the Department of Homeland Security Grant funding. Should the funds be reduced, the impact will be felt in the grant management, law enforcement and preparedness areas. Funding in maintaining the communication and law enforcement equipment that was purchased previously would be critical to the counties and the state agencies. Should the loss of federal funds be significant enough to eliminate these maintenance funds, the state may have to provide approximately \$600,000 for the Counties and another \$300,000 to state agencies.

Please note that there is not enough information at this time to confirm that the above scenarios will take place and every effort will be made to work with the federal funding agencies to insure that any reduction is held to a minimum.

Budget Request

Due to the large reductions absorbed in the personnel and funding to contribute the department's share in the State's effort to reduce the budget deficit, the guidance was given to restore funds for critical services in line with the Governor's "New Day Plan". (1) Request for the establishment of positions and funding required to restore critical services, (2) Request restoration of General Funds that were lost due to vacancies and for positions that were converted to federal funds, (3) Request funds for the replacement of equipment that the repair cost exceeds the equipments' depreciated value, and (4) Request funds for utility cost increases, repair and maintenance of facilities, minor and major construction projects that enhance health, safety and energy efficiency requirements.

Mission Statement

The Office of Veterans' Services is the principal State office responsible for the development and management of policies and programs concerning veterans and their family members, and provides services related to these Veterans and their family members.

Economic Impact

Overall, the services provided by the State Office of Veterans' Services (OVS) has remained at a high operations tempo, while the demand for these services has also continuously increased. The latest Department of Veterans Affairs State Summaries as of September 30, 2014 reflected 121,007 veterans in Hawaii with over 40,000 active duty personnel. Last fiscal year's total was 116,000 Veterans. With the complete troop withdrawal from Iraq in 2011 and Afghanistan in 2014, along with military mission changes slated for Hawaii, the expectation is that there will be a dramatic increase in case management and queries from military members, Veterans, and their families with more military members separating or transitioning to Veterans status.

On the personnel side, OVS filled four billets in the last year and is aggressively pursuing the filling of five more positions located at our Oahu, Hawaii, Kauai, and Maui offices. We also have the services of two (2) volunteers who assist with OVS duties at the Hawaii State Veterans Cemetery in Kaneohe and here at Tripler.

OVS's monthly reports for last fiscal year indicates we saw a total of 52, 287 individuals which is slightly down from our numbers last reporting of 57, 828. The availability and decrease of the counselor corps due to retirements contributed to this lower contact count. The Veteran's cemeteries statewide have also noted an increase in the number of World War II and Korean War veterans and their spouses who are passing and in need of burial services.

The OVS and VA are serving younger war veterans and a significant number of older (age 65 and older) Veterans. Many Veterans in both of these groups are requiring care for physical and mental injuries suffered in the service of their country. All VA medical projections show that many younger Veterans are affected by post-traumatic stress disorder and traumatic brain injury while older Veterans who served in Vietnam are suffering from Ischemic heart disease, adult onset diabetes, Parkinson's disease, and an array of cancers. All of these conditions may be related to their military service. In addition to traumatic brain injuries, gunshot wounds and other combat injuries; our Veterans suffer from motorcycle and automobile accidents, suicides, homelessness, and unemployment. Veterans need to know where to go for assistance as they are dealing with these and other problems. Consequently, outreach programs like "Veterans Stand Down's," Job Fairs, and Veteran Workshops are vitally important and serve a great purpose. They support our Veterans and their families with a well-trained staff to address their

specific concerns and provide the foundation for future short-term or long-term supportive services based on eligibility prerequisites.

Federal Funds

One of the major roles of the OVS is to ensure that individuals who are eligible for VA benefits and medical care receive these services. This relieves the state from providing direct services to these individuals. In Federal FY 2014, the VA spent \$723 million in Hawaii on Veterans receiving Compensation and Pensions, Education and Vocational Rehabilitation programs, and Medical Care. The VA provided highly skilled, skilled, and unskilled jobs to over 600 residents of Hawaii. A viable State Office of Veterans Services with satellite locations on Maui, Kauai, Hawaii, and Oahu along with monthly outreach services to Molokai and Lanai, offers an important link in aligning our Veterans and eligible dependents with these federal resources. Currently, for the Federal Capital Improvement and Operating and Maintenance Projects that were approved in FY 15, over \$7.5M dollars have been received and are slated for Hawaii State Veterans Cemetery Projects State-wide.

Budget Request

The OVS Budget request for this biennium did not meet the Governor's supportable list at this time due to higher priority requirements taking precedence and because of limited resources. The original request for budget reflected increases various health and safety repairs and maintenance work needed at the Hawaii State Veterans Cemetery at Kaneohe and the final phase of the Grave restoration Project at the Maui Veterans Cemetery (\$2.6M). This covers repairing the walkways at the ceremonial plaza, repairs needed at the Monument Plaza and Maintenance Facility, a clean-out of our storm drainage system, repaving, and tree pruning. State funds are also required to complete the Maui Grave Restoration Phase II Project that will complete this operations and maintenance project that comes with federal matching dollars. Additionally, State funds are required for the design and management of Grave Restoration State-wide (Kauai, Hawaii, Oahu). Other requests include laptops for counselors conducting outreach services in the field (\$17.8K), replacing older vehicles as repair costs start to rise for upkeep, and other maintenance equipment for our burial operations (\$178K). This office will work with DAGS surplus to acquire vehicles at a reasonable and fair market price.

Overview

The Mission of the National Guard Youth Challenge Programs is to intervene and reclaim the lives of "at-risk" youth to produce program graduates with the values, skills, educational and self-discipline necessary to succeed as adults.

The mission of the Hawaii National Guard Youth Challenge Academy (YCA) is to provide an opportunity for 16-18 year old "at-risk" youth to learn the skills needed to be successful, responsible and productive citizens in the community while affording them the opportunity to earn a high school equivalency diploma.

The vision of the National Guard Youth Challenge Program is to be recognized as America's premier program for "at-risk" youth.

The Academy provides the State of Hawaii with a progressive alternative school for "at-risk" youth that focuses on lessons in character education, morals, values, life-coping skills and responsible citizenship.

Economic Impact

In State of Hawaii, total enrollment in Grade 9 to Grade 12 in 2012 is 65,953 ¹ and the Statewide graduation rate for all students is 80.9%. That means there are over 12,000 students who did not attain their high school diplomas. There is a need for alternate programs such as Youth Challenge Academy to offer a second chance to the high school drop outs to achieve their high school equivalent diplomas.

The State of Hawaii spent on average \$11,587 of General Fund per pupil in year 2011-2012 ¹. In comparison, Youth Challenge Academy is authorized to spend \$16,000 per cadet of which \$12,000 or 75% is Federal Funds and \$4,000 or 25% is State matching share from General Funds. This is equivalent to savings of \$7,587 per pupil to the State of Hawaii.

The Program is authorized to receive \$5,584,387 Federal funds per year to operate two locations at Kalaeloa, Oahu and Hilo, Big Island of Hawaii. (CFDA Number 12-404). The matching State fund is authorized at \$1,571,282 for fiscal year 2015 (Act 122 SLH 2014).

Budget Request

We are requesting to increase cost per cadet to \$20,000. 75% or \$15,000 will be Federal Funds and the State matching share at 25% is \$5,000. This calculates to an increase of \$1,200,000 federal appropriations and \$400,000 State General funds. The existing operating budget of \$16,000 per cadet was established over 9 years ago. Based on studies and review on the present economic trend, it was perceptible that the current high cost of living makes it difficult to sustain the care and maintenance for the facilities and to provide funding for post-graduate training programs, and improve further educational/job skills opportunities.

The high cost of operation of the two Youth Challenge Programs on Oahu and Big Island is primarily due to the fact that they are both 24/7 operations. Personnel and operational costs to ensure the health and safety of the Cadets escalate every year. The cost of operating a residential program is about double that of a conventional school when taken into considerations the costs of meals, uniforms, school supplies, transportation as well as utilities, and facilities maintenance. The recent increase in utilities cost definitely made an impact on the operation budget.

The realization of this budget increase request will allow the Program to restore many elements that were put aside. At present time, element such as weekly and graduate stipends, which are an incentive for cadets to enroll and complete the program are suspended. These stipends are a form of financial aid to cadets for their college or trade school application fees and other personal incidentals while attending the academy. Registration for vocational training classes offered in Community Colleges can also be restored to provide a broader curriculum to the cadets during the school cycle. These classes are to ensure the cadets receive practical skills upon their graduations.

Alternatives Considered

The Youth Challenge Academy at Kalaeloa has been in partnership with Waipahu Community School for Adults for over 20 years and has offered the General Educational Development (GED), and Competency-Based Community School Diploma Program (CBCSDP) as a means to a high school equivalent diploma. Over the last 19 years or 40 class cycles, the Kalaeloa program has had 3,543 Cadets completed the program and 82 % of them earning their equivalent high school diplomas. Class 41, the most recent cycle to graduate from Kalaeloa YCA had 96 Cadets completed and 96 graduates (100%) attained their high school equivalent diplomas. One of the Academy's goals is to work at increasing the number of graduates to 250 per year (or 125 per cycle) and continue to increase the number of high school equivalent diplomas awarded each year.

Since its inception in 2011, YCA's partnership with the Department of Education has offered the Hilo YCA program the Competency-Based Community School Diploma Program (CBCSDP) high school equivalent diploma to our cadets. The development of the Hilo program at our new

location at Keaukaha Military Reservation continues with the completion of class 08. The Hilo YCA has graduated a total of 342 Cadets in this 4 year span with 80% of them receiving high school equivalent diplomas.

Youth Challenge Academy continues diligently to improve our performance by mentoring, and graduating more successful youth and thereby operating with more efficiency. This performance will be judged by the future success of our graduates, not just by the graduation percentage. YCA has pursued partnerships with organizations that benefit the Cadets in both the residential and post-residential phases of the program. A few of these partnerships are the Hawaii Community College system, the State Trades Council, Military recruitment programs and many local businesses. These partnerships have arranged placement for YCA graduates into higher education, vocational training, work force and the military services to fulfil their post residential requirements. Over the years, there are graduates achieving the goal of the Youth Challenge Academy to become productive members of society and positive contributors to their communities.

Future

The immediate priority is the continued development of the Hilo program on Big Island of Hawaii and the improvement of operations at Barbers Point Kalaeloa. The future addition of one more billeting wing which can accommodate 50 more Cadets at the Hilo Program will ensure operation of Youth Challenge Academy at its maximum capacities to assist the youth in need.

An ongoing vision has been to locate a new site for the Kalaeloa Academy. At the present time, the program is housed in Korean War-era Navy Barracks; the classrooms are in a converted Fitness Center. With the dramatic increase in the number of residents in and around Kalaeloa facilities, the Cadets are faced with many opportunities for negative interactions. It has created a clear and present danger for the Cadres and Staff to monitor the safety and well-being of the Cadets. Locating a suitable site with good security and safe environment is a priority goal. This can be achieved by encouraging private donations through the Hawaii National Guard Youth Challenge Academy Foundation (501 (c) 3) and combine that with State funds to help with construction and relocation costs.

The final aspiration is an idea for future support and funding for a Job Opportunities Training Program, or *Job Challenge* to work in conjunction with the Hawaii Youth Challenge Programs. This will be a vocational and technical training school provided to Youth Challenge graduates in Pacific regions. Courses in carpentry, masonry, welding, vehicle repairs and maintenance, landscaping, agriculture and other endeavors would offer an in-house placement and mentorship to Cadets after graduating from the Academies. It will be 100% Federal funded in partnership with the Department of Labor. A location on Oahu would give all the Youth Challenge Program Graduates from the Western States the opportunity to be placed at competitive entry level positions.
