In consideration of Supplemental Budget Request for GOV 100 for FY21

Chair Luke, Vice Chair Cullen, and committee members:

The Office of the Governor seeks to restore confidence in government by establishing a sustainable Hawaii so future generations can call Hawaii home.

The Governor is the Chief Executive Officer of the State of Hawai'i's Executive Branch and our Head of State, representing Hawai'i in national and international affairs. In addition to our O'ahu office, we have four neighbor island offices to serve our constituents across the state. The governor's senior staff includes Chief of Staff, Chief of Operations, and Directors of Communication, Executive Administrative Services, Intergovernmental Relations and Policy, and Protocol Officer

We are respectfully requesting \$60,000 in the supplemental year ending June 2021. We appreciate initial funding received for FY2020 to support the Office of the Governor's protocol initiatives. These funds are vital to support efforts to develop and maintain intergovernmental relationships that advances the various interests of our state. We are requesting \$50,000 to continue protocol initiatives.

We are also requesting \$10,000 to begin planning activities leading to the 175th Anniversary of Washington Place. Designated as a National Historic Landmark, Washington Place has been an integral part of much of Hawaii's history. Thoughtful and dedicated planning will help ensure that the anniversary celebration honors its history.

We appreciate your attention and will be available to answer your questions, should you have any at this time. Thank you for your continued support of the Governor's Office budget.
