Subject: LTG 100

A. Overview

- Pursuant to Article V, Section 4 of the Hawaii State Constitution, the primary mission of the Lieutenant Governor is to act in place of the Governor in his absence. Accordingly, the Lieutenant Governor must keep abreast of the actions and issues regarding the Administration to ensure he can effectively carry out the necessary functions of the office during these absences. Pursuant to Section 26-1, Hawaii Revised Statues, another core function of the Office of the Lieutenant Governor is to serve as Secretary of State for intergovernmental relations. In this role, the Lieutenant Governor is charged with directing and performing a multitude of activities for the public, which are administrative and coordinative in nature. These activities include the processing of name changes, issuing apostilles and certifications, and selling state publications. Such fees are deposited into the general fund and do not go towards funding the operation of the Lieutenant Governor's Office. Last fiscal year the Office processed 1,570 name changes.
- **B.** Section 26-1 indicates that, "governor shall identify and direct other duties as necessary to the lieutenant governor." In 2019 Governor David Ige designated the Lieutenant Governor as the point person on homelessness as it relates to public-private partnerships.
 - A major initiative of the Lieutenant Governor's Office is Kauhale. Kauhale is a community centered master planned development that may include tiny homes or low to moderate high rise depending on the footprint and feasibility at each location. With the help of multiple state agencies, seven parcels of State land have been identified across Oahu. Homeaide Hawaii, a non-profit organization has partnered with the State to build Kauhale. Homeaide Hawaii brings professional labor, materials, and services to address homelessness in our local communities through financial and in-kind donations.

The Lieutenant Governor is also supporting the Governor with disaster preparedness and the healthcare worker shortage.

C. Federal Funds

The Office does not receive or expend federal funds.

D. Non-General Funds

The Office does not receive or expend non-general funds.

E. Budget Requests

- The budget was put together based on the prior year's activity. The budget supports the administrative functions of the Lieutenant Governor's Office and the special initiatives assigned by the Governor.
- **F.** The Office of the Lieutenant Governor requests that an operating budget of \$994,269.00 be appropriated for FY 2021. We ask that the Legislature consider an increase of \$16,714 for travel. This increase will support the Lieutenant Governor's work on homelessness and other important projects.
