SB 2782, SD1 (HSCR1175-22) Status	RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS. Provides appropriations for collective bargaining cost items for the members of Unit (1) and their excluded counterparts, including the cost of salary adjustments negotiated between the State and the bargaining unit representative for fiscal biennium 2021-2023. (SD1)	LAT, FIN
SB 2790, SD1 (HSCR1183-22) Status	RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS. Provides appropriations for collective bargaining cost items for the members of Unit (9) and their excluded counterparts, including the cost of salary adjustments negotiated between the State and the bargaining unit representative for fiscal biennium 2021-2023. <u>SB 2791, SD1, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1184-22)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS. Appropriates and authorizes funds for collective bargaining cost items for the members of bargaining unit (10) and their excluded counterparts, including the cost of salary adjustments negotiated between the State and the bargaining unit representative for fiscal biennium 2021-2023. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)	LAT, FIN
<u>SB 3289, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1433-22)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HAWAII RETIREMENT SAVINGS. Establishes the Hawaii retirement savings program, administered by the Hawaii retirement savings board, in consultation with the department of labor and industrial relations and department of budget and finance, to provide a state-facilitated payroll-deduction individual retirement savings plan to private sector employees who do not have access to employer-sponsored retirement savings plans beginning on an implementation date to be determined by the board. Requires an implementation and evaluation study, followed by an implementation strategy and timetable, prior to implementation of the program. Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)	LAT, CPC, FIN
<u>SB 573, SD1</u> <u>(HSCR1287-22)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO WILDLIFE. Requires all habitat conservation plans to include an agreement for plan participants to enter into and maintain an annual service contract with a stand-by and response facility available to provide emergency medical and rehabilitation services to native wildlife affected by activities undertaken within the plan area. Takes effect 7/30/2050. (SD1)	WAL, JHA, FIN
<u>SB 2398, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1173-22)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY. Creates the Pulehunui community development district to allow for planning, development, and maintenance of public lands in Pulehunui, Maui. Amends the Hawaii community development authority membership to include the director of business, economic development, and tourism, chairperson of the board of land and natural resources, and director of the office of planning and permitting of each county, or their respective designees, in which a community development district is located. Amends community representatives on each board from three to two at-large members. Establishes membership for quorum on matters related to the Pulehunui community development district. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)	WAL, FIN

<u>SB 1138, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1392)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF HEALTHCARE ASSURANCE SPECIAL FUND. Provides that the annual expenditure ceiling of the office of healthcare assurance special fund shall be established through the state budget process. Authorizes emergency spending beyond the established budget ceiling. Effective 7/1/2060. (HD1)	HHH, FIN
