<u>HB 2075, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR783-22)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO FIREARMS. Increases the time frame that a permit to acquire a firearm can be used to thirty days. Eliminates physical inspection of firearms generally, except under certain circumstances. Effective 1/1/2222. (HD1)	JDC
