SB 3343 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO FIREWORKS. Requires importers of fireworks to obtain a license from the Harbors Division of the Department of Transportation. Requires annual report to the Legislature.	TRS/PSM, CPN
SB 3165 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO OPERATING A VEHICLE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF AN INTOXICANT. Lengthens the driver's license revocation period for first time offenders convicted of operating a vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant who do not install an ignition interlock device. Allows early termination of driver's license revocation after nine months upon showing three consecutive months of ignition interlock use without any violations.	TRS/PSM, JDC
SB 355 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO REGISTRATION FEES. Reduces the annual vehicle registration fee by fifty per cent for disabled veterans who have fifty per cent or more but less than one hundred per cent service-connected disability rating.	TRS/PSM, WAM
SB 2534 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE HAWAII HARBOR OCEAN SAFETY COMMITTEE. Establishes the Hawaii Harbor Ocean Safety Committee.	TRS/PSM, WTL/WAM

Repeals the 3-year limit on the exemption of the State and counties from the requirement to maintain or improve any condemned roads. Abolishes joint and several liability of the State and counties for any condemned roads.
