Authorizes the Department of Transportation Harbor Police to enforce laws and rules adopted by the Department of Land and Natural Resources relating to ocean recreation.

RELATING TO METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATIONS.

Creates a temporary intergovernmental task force to assist in the establishment and certification of a metropolitan planning organization for the county of Hawaii. Requires the Department of Transportation to provide a list of certain highway projects to the task force. Requires a report to the legislature.
