

WAIANAE COAST FLOOD MITIGATION TOWN HALL MEETING SUMMARY

57 individuals signed in for the Waianae Coast Flood Mitigation Town Hall Meeting held on March 28, 2012 at the Waianae District Park and 67 in total attended the meeting including presenters and volunteers. Of the 57 individuals who signed in, 21 meeting feedback forms were received indicating a 37% response rate.
