Petroleum Contaminates Water Near Red Hill

After lab reports revealed petroleum contaminants in the Navy's water system, Gov. Ige and Hawaii's congressional delegation called for the Navy to suspend its Red Hill fuel storage operation.

While the Navy has shutdown the Red Hill water shaft, hundreds of families have reported feeling sick, developing skin rashes, and nauseous. The contamination of the water well under Red Hill is absolutely unacceptable. That is why I have signed my name on a letter urging the U.S Navy to decommission the Red Hill Fuel Storage Facility.

This incident is shocking, but not surprising. In 2014, a fuel tank on Red Hill leaked 27,000 gallons of fuel—prompting outrage and leading to frequent testing of the water well. As the Navy, State, and City move to address the immediate needs of the families and prevent further contamination, this is a reminder on how proactive investments in our infrastructure can help protect our communities. With \$2.8 billion coming to Hawaii from President Biden's infrastructure bill, I will work to secure funds to improve critical infrastructure in our communities.
