# COVID-19 VACCINE FOR AGES 5-11

## Vaccine Information 5 to 11 Year-Olds



The Hawai'i Department of Health is authorizing certified vaccination providers to administer Pfizer's COVID-19 vaccine for children age 5-11 *immediately*.

Over 200 locations statewide including medical facilities, community health centers, mobile clinics, pharmacies, pediatrician's offices, and more than 130 public, private and charter schools will be providing vaccinations.

Some participating schools will begin administering COVID-19 vaccinations on *Monday, November 8<sup>th</sup>*
