
**DTS Safety Updates: Bus Stop & Sidewalks**

- Due to safety concerns, the Department of Transportation Services (DTS) will temporarily relocate TheBus stop at 3650 Waiialae Ave. The stop will be moved one block uphill on Waiialae Ave., between Koko Head and 12th Ave.
- This change will take place for several weeks in October, after which the bus stop will return to its original location at 3650 Waiialae Ave.
- While TheBus stop is temporarily relocated, businesses and their customers may use the metered and loading stalls on the Ewa-side of Koko Head Ave. for pick-up and drop-off.
- The sidewalk fronting 3650 Waiialae Ave. will remain open except for approximately one month in October 2021 and at the end of the project when the sidewalks and other pedestrian safety elements must be incorporated.

### Yes, if...

- 1 I have been fully vaccinated with the Pfizer vaccine.
- 2 It has been at least 6 months since I have been fully vaccinated.
- 3 I am between the ages of 18-49 with underlying medical condition(s).
- or
- 4 I am between the ages of 18-64 and at high risk for occupational or institutional exposure.

### Priority goes to:

- People receiving their first and second doses.
- Individuals age 65 and older and individuals age 50-64 with underlying medical conditions.
