Congratulations to Moanalua High School's Varsity Football Team for capturing the 2009 Oahu Interscholastic Association (OIA) Championship (Division II) for the first time in the school's 37 year history! The team earned the title after a victorious 21-7 win against Aiea High School, which gave them the OIA record of 10-0 and overall 10-2, the best record in Moanalua High School's history. The triumph also qualified Na Menehune to the Hawaii High School Athletic Association's State Football Tournament for the second time in their school's history.
