Constitutional Amendments; Board of Education HB 2376, HD3, SD2, CD1

**Proposes a constitutional amendment to have the Board of Education members nominated by, and appointed by the Governor, with advise and consent of the Senate

"Shall the Board of Education be changed to a board appointed by the Governor, with the advise and consent of the Senate, as provided by law?"

If voters elect yes, it would restructure the Board of Education

Nomination Commission *HB2377 HD3 SD2 CD1* **Details the composition of the BOE's members (9 members) and their term limits

**Establishes an advisory council that would provide the governor a list of qualified candidates from which to appoint members to the board

Restoration of Instructional Days; Hawaii Hurricane

Relief Fund; Appropriation SB2124 SD2 HD1 CD1 **Provides funding to solve the furlough Friday issue in Hawaii's public schools by making a \$67 million appropriation from the Hawaii hurricane relief fund to restore instructional days for the 2010-2011 school year **Money would only be released upon completion of negotiations of the parties involved
