Physiologic Considerations and Perceived Exertion for Face Mask Wear During Moderate to Vigorous Activity in School-Aged Children (lead PI)

August 2021 - January 2022

IRB approved prospective study of 50 patients with primary objective of learning if there are significant changes in physiological variables of heart rate, temperature, oxygen saturation and blood pressure in children participating in moderate to vigorous physical activity when using a face mask. Secondary Objective: to determine if patients' perceived exertion during moderate to vigorous physical activity with use of a face mask coincides with their objective physiologic measures. Study closed due to recruitment confines related to pandemic precautions.
