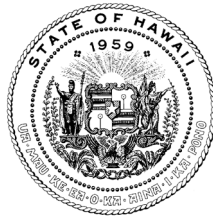

In consideration of
HOUSE BILL 1673
RELATING TO PARKING CONCESSIONS

House Bill 1673 proposes to exempt parking concessions from the public bidding requirements under the state procurement law. **The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) strongly supports this measure.**

The Department operates vehicle parking plans through its various divisions and has found that being restricted to only offering vehicle parking plans by either Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) Chapter 102 or 103D to be disadvantageous and requests the ability to offer vehicle parking plans using different procurement methods other than being limited to using HRS, Chapter 102. This will give the Department the ability to create parking plans that are more advantageous to the State and can be tailored to specific locations and conditions on a case by case basis. The Department will follow the appropriate procurement code when issuing solicitations for parking services.
