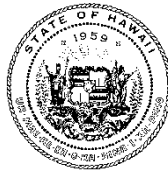

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on this bill.¹ The Campaign Spending Commission (“Commission”) supports this bill.

This bill amends Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) §11-322 and §11-323 to require the Commission to publish on its website the names of candidates and persons who qualify as noncandidate committees who fail to file an organizational report or correct an organizational report with the Commission. A committee cannot file the required disclosure reports without first registering with the Commission by filing an organizational report. This measure will motivate committees to file the organizational report and to file amended organizational reports when information in the report changes.

The Commission requests that this committee pass this bill.
