A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to amend Act 125,
2 Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, to extend the time to expend
3 appropriations for the establishment of a pilot visitation and
4 family resource center at Waiawa correctional facility on Oahu,
5 and make conforming amendments related to the establishment of
6 the department of corrections and rehabilitation.

7 SECTION 2. Act 125, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, is
8 amended by amending sections 3 and 4 to read as follows:

9 "SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$305,000 or so much
11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the
12 establishment of a pilot visitation and family resource center
13 at Waiawa correctional facility on Oahu.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
15 human services for the purposes of this Act.

16 The appropriation made by this section for fiscal year
17 2022-2023 shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for



1 which the appropriation is made; provided that any unexpended
2 and unencumbered balance of the appropriation as of the close of
3 business on June 30, 2024, shall lapse on that date.

4 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$115,000 or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the
7 establishment of a pilot visitation and family resource center
8 at Waiawa correctional facility on Oahu.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
10 public safety or its successor department of corrections and
11 rehabilitation for the purposes of this Act.

12 The appropriation made by this section for fiscal year
13 2022-2023 shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for
14 which the appropriation is made; provided that any unexpended
15 and unencumbered balance of the appropriation as of the close of
16 business on December 31, 2023, shall be transferred to the
17 department of corrections and rehabilitation pursuant to section
18 48 of Act 278, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022; provided further
19 that any unexpended and unencumbered balance of the
20 appropriation as of the close of business on June 30, 2024,
21 shall lapse on that date."



- 1 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2023.
