# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE LIBRARY SYSTEM.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 312-2.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows: 3 "(d) The state librarian shall: [collect, purchase, receive gifts of, and 4 (1) 5 otherwise acquire all books and other publications proper for libraries, and arrange, classify, manage, 6 7 and catalog the same; [provide] Provide for [their] safekeeping[+] of the 8 (2) 9 foregoing; [expend] Expend moneys appropriated by the legislature 10 (3) 11 and otherwise acquired for the development, use, 12 support, and maintenance of libraries and other 13 related purposes; (4) [provide] Provide ways and means for placing libraries 14 15 within reach of all residents throughout the State and 16 particularly of all public and private school 17 children:

1	(5)	[provide] Provide and maintain branch libraries,
2		offices, or places for the distribution of books and
3		periodicals throughout the State;
4	(6)	[enter] Enter into contracts as may be necessary to

7		deemed necessary, all of whom shall be under the
8		authority of the governor for purposes of chapters 76
9		78, 89, and 89C; [ <del>and</del> ]
10	(8)	Impose and collect rates, rents, fees, fines, and
11		charges for the use or enjoyment and services of the
12		facilities of each state library facility; provided
13		that the contracting for concessions within a library
14		facility shall not be subject to section 102-14;
15	(9)	Revise rates, rents, fees, fines, and charges imposed
16		pursuant to paragraph (8) upon approval of the board
17		of education; and
18	(10)	[adopt] Adopt rules for the management and use of
19		libraries, and for the control of the property under

3	" (đ)	[The] Without regard to chapter 91, the state
4	librarian	shall prescribe the procedures relating to:
5	(1)	The charging of fees;
6	(2)	The waiver of fees;
7	(3)	The documents, materials, and services for which fees
8		may be charged;
9	(4)	The amount of the fees that may be assessed and
10		charged to a library patron;
11	(5)	The accumulated amount of lost library material costs,
12		fines, or fees;
13	(6)	The period of time that the lost library materials
14		costs, fines, or fees [must] shall remain unpaid
15		before they may be referred to a collection agency for
16		collection [pursuant to rules adopted under chapter
17		91]; and
18	(7)	The notification of persons [with] having delinquent
19		accounts of the additional fees to be charged by the
20		collection agency prior to the referral to the
21		collection agency "

- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 4 provided that on June 30, 2028, this Act shall be repealed and
- 5 sections 312-2.1 and 312-4.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be
- 6 reenacted in the form in which they read on the day before the
- 7 effective date of this Act.
