# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 2 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 4 appropriations contained in H.B. No. 300, H.D. 1, S.D. 1,
- 5 C.D. 1, and this Act will cause the state general fund
- 6 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-2024 to be exceeded by
- 7 \$1,063,847,367 or 11.0 per cent. This current declaration takes
- 8 into account general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal
- 9 year 2023-2024 in H.B. No. 300, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, C.D. 1, and this
- 10 Act only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund
- 11 expenditure ceiling are that:
- 12 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
- serve the public interest; and
- 14 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
- 15 addressed by this Act.
- 16 SECTION 2. The legislature finds that Act 51, Session Laws
- 17 of Hawaii 2004 (Act 51), transferred the control of certain
- 18 functions of executive branch agencies that pertained to 2023-2951 SB1141 CD1 SMA-3.docx

- 1 education personnel and facilities to the department of
- 2 education to increase operational efficiency while reducing
- 3 bureaucracy. However, after enactment of Act 51, the department
- 4 of human resources development continued to provide most
- 5 services to the employees of the Hawaii state public library
- 6 system. Eight years later, Act 61 (Act 61), Session Laws of
- 7 Hawaii 2012, clarified that the transfer of functions by Act 51
- 8 was not intended to include the Hawaii state public library
- 9 system or its employees.
- 10 The legislature further finds that despite the
- 11 clarification provided by Act 61, the aspects of workers'
- 12 compensation for Hawaii state public library system employees
- 13 continue to be within the functions of the department of
- 14 education, and not within the functions of the department of
- 15 human resources development. The legislature also finds that
- 16 the department of human resources development has not received
- 17 any additional staff or funding from the department of education
- 18 to address its increased responsibilities to the Hawaii state
- 19 public library system and its employees as a consequence of Act
- 20 61.
- 21 The purpose of this Act is to:

I	(1)	Transfer:
2		(A) The rights, powers, functions, duties, resources,
3		and individual budget of the Hawaii state public
4		library system relating to workers' compensation
5		for its employees to the department of human
6		resources development; and
7		(B) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent
8		position from the Hawaii state public library
9		system to the department of human resources
10		development; and
11	(2)	Appropriate funds for the salary and benefits of one
12		full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) human resources
13		specialist position to the department of human
14		resources development for the management and
15		administration of workers' compensation for the Hawaii
16		state public library system and its employees.
17	SECT	ION 3. Effective July 1, 2023:
18	(1)	All rights, powers, functions, duties, resources, and
19		the individual budget of the Hawaii state public
20		library system relating to workers' compensation for
21		its employees are transferred to the department of

1	human resources development, subject to amendment or		
2	repeal by subsequent legislation; and		
3	(2) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent position		
4	shall be transferred to the department of human		
5	resources development from the Hawaii state public		
6	library system.		
7	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general		
8	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$80,000 or so much		
9	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 for the		
10	salary and benefits of one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) human		
11	resources specialist position to the department of human		
12	resources development for the management and administration of		
13	workers' compensation for the Hawaii state public library system		
14	and its employees.		
15	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
16	human resources development for the purposes of this Act.		
17	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
