A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SCHOOL FACILITIES AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, occasionally,
2 statutes require clarifying amendments. While often technical,
3 these amendments can include substantive elements, which should
4 be thoroughly considered.

5 The legislature further finds that section 13 of Act 217,
6 Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, replaced the terms "department",
7 "board", or "board of education" with "school facilities
8 authority" in section 302A-1151.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The
9 amended statute, however, contains redundant and confusing
10 references that need clarification.

11 The purpose of this Act is to make necessary amendments to
12 clarify certain references to the school facilities authority
13 used in section 302A-1151.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

14 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1151.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
15 is amended as follows:

16 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:

17 "(a) There shall be established within the school
18 facilities authority a pilot program for the lease of public



1 school land, including facilities. The school facilities
2 authority, in consultation with [~~the school facilities authority~~
3 ~~and~~] any other appropriate agency, shall serve as the
4 facilitator of the pilot program."


5 2. By amending subsection (d) to read:

6 "(d) Nothing in this section shall preclude the school
7 facilities authority from working with and receiving assistance
8 from any other [~~school facilities authority~~] department or
9 agency in carrying out the purposes of this section."

10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
