A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE BUILDING CODE COUNCIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 107-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) There is established a state building code council.
4 The council shall be placed within the department of accounting
5 and general services for administrative purposes only. The
6 council shall consist of [~~eleven~~] twelve voting members and one
7 nonvoting member, who shall be the comptroller or the
8 comptroller's designee. The council members shall serve
9 four-year terms. The voting members shall include:

- 10 (1) One county building official from each of the four
- 11 counties appointed by the mayor;
- 12 (2) One member representing the state fire council;
- 13 (3) One member representing the department of labor and
- 14 industrial relations, who has significant experience
- 15 in elevator safety;




- 1 (4) One member representing the Hawaii state energy office
2 of the department of business, economic development,
3 and tourism;
- 4 (5) One member representing the Hawaii emergency
5 management agency, appointed by the director of Hawaii
6 emergency management;
- 7 ~~[(5)]~~ (6) One member representing the Structural Engineers
8 Association of Hawaii;
- 9 ~~[(6)]~~ (7) One member representing the American Institute of
10 Architects, Hawaii State Council;
- 11 ~~[(7)]~~ (8) One member representing the Building Industry
12 Association of Hawaii or the General Contractors
13 Association of Hawaii, who has significant experience
14 with building codes, with alternating four-year terms
15 between the two organizations and the first four-year
16 term to be served by the Building Industry Association
17 of Hawaii; and
- 18 ~~[(8)]~~ (9) One member representing the Subcontractors'
19 Association of Hawaii, who has significant experience
20 with building codes."



1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.


