
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIQUOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 281-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (u) to read as follows:

3 "(u) Any provision to the contrary notwithstanding~~[, a]~~:

4 (1) A patron may remove from any class of licensed
5 premises any portion of wine, liquor, or beer that was
6 purchased on or brought onto the premises of the
7 licensee engaged in meal service for consumption with
8 a meal; provided that ~~it~~ the wine, liquor, or beer
9 is recorked or resealed in its original container~~[-]~~;
10 and

11 (2) Licensees engaged in meal service may sell with food
12 unopened:

13 (A) Beer;

14 (B) Wine; and

15 (C) Prepackaged cocktails,

16 for pick up, delivery, take out, or other means to be
17 consumed off-premises."



1 SECTION 2. Section 281-39, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) A license issued under this chapter shall authorize
4 the doing of the business licensed only at the place described
5 in the license, which shall be known as the licensed premises,
6 except:

7 (1) In case of a removal with the prior written consent of
8 the liquor commission indorsed on the license, or
9 outside warehousing which may be located off the
10 licensed premises with prior written consent of the
11 liquor commission; [~~and~~]

12 (2) That the units that are used to provide transient
13 lodging under a class 15 license may change from time
14 to time; provided that the condominium hotel operator
15 shall submit quarterly to the commission the list of
16 units being utilized as part of the condominium hotel
17 and maintains a current list pursuant to section
18 281-35.5 at a condominium hotel for inspection by any
19 authorized employee of the commission[~~-~~]; and

20 (3) Any provision to the contrary notwithstanding, that a
21 licensee holding a class 4 retail dealer license may



1 deliver a customer's purchased liquor to the
2 customer's vehicle located at a nearby curbside or
3 other designated location."

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.

Liquor Licenses; Sales; Off-premises Consumption; Curbside Delivery

Description:

Authorizes liquor licensees to sell unopened beer, wine, and prepackaged cocktails with food for pick up, delivery, take out, or other means to be consumed off-premises. Authorizes liquor licensees holding class 4 retail dealer licenses to deliver purchased liquor to a customer's vehicle. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)
