
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND
TOURISM TO ESTABLISH A PROGRAM TO PROVIDE GRANTS FOR HOTEL
EMPLOYEES, OR ENTITIES ENTIRELY OWNED BY HOTEL EMPLOYEES,
TO PURCHASE HOTELS AND CONVERT THEM INTO EMPLOYEE-OWNED
COOPERATIVES.

1 WHEREAS, according to the University of Hawaii, the
2 accommodation and food services sector of the State's economy
3 employed 113,417 people in 2020; and
4

5 WHEREAS, throughout the State, many hotels are privately
6 owned by multinational corporations having directors,
7 executives, and shareholders that are not residents of the
8 State; and
9

10 WHEREAS, hotels are bought and sold on the open market
11 regularly; and
12

13 WHEREAS, numerous industries throughout the United States
14 operate successfully as cooperatives; and
15

16 WHEREAS, there are numerous examples of successful
17 employee-owned hotels throughout the world, including The Priory
18 Hotel in Scotland, the hotels of Quaintance-Weaver Restaurants
19 and Hotels in North Carolina, and the hotels of TPI Hospitality
20 in Minnesota; and

22 WHEREAS, developing a process for employees of a bankrupt
23 hotel to purchase and operate that hotel as a cooperative
24 business could prevent increased unemployment in the State; and

26 WHEREAS, accordingly, it is appropriate for the State to
27 provide grants to match funds for hotel employees to buy hotels
28 and establish employee-owned hotel cooperatives; now, therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
2 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
3 Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
4 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism is urged to
5 establish a program to provide grants for hotel employees, or
6 entities entirely owned by hotel employees, to purchase hotels
7 and convert them into employee-owned hotel cooperatives; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Business,
10 Economic Development, and Tourism is requested to require
11 employees and entities to provide matching funds on a
12 dollar-for-dollar basis to qualify for grants under the program;

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
16 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of
17 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism.
