The sums hereinabove may be paid to the 14 respective persons, firms, corporations, or entities for the 15 satisfaction or settlement of the respectively identified cases, 16 and in several amounts hereinabove set forth or in lesser 17 amounts deemed appropriate, upon checks issued by the 18 comptroller; provided that departments shall obtain the approval 19 of the attorney general before payment of any claim may be made. 20 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as 21 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest 22 shall be limited to the period from the date of the judgment, if 23 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,

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as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those
 cases to which the statute applies.

3 SECTION 5. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
4 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
5 June 30, 2024, shall lapse.

6 SECTION 6. If any provision of this Act, or the 7 application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held 8 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or 9 applications of the Act that can be given effect without the 10 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions 11 of this Act are severable.

12 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
