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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FOURTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$18,805,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the  
6 fourteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Kalihi Uka elementary school

8           A. Plans, design, equipment, and  
9           construction to stabilize the  
10           foundation in buildings A and C,  
11           stabilize walkways in building C,  
12           and surround the school with a  
13           six-foot perimeter fence for  
14           safety.

12 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital  
 13 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 14 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are  
 15 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are  
 16 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

17 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
 18 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
 19 expended by the department of education for the purposes of this  
 20 Act.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
