
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEAT PROCESSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a need to
2 increase the meat processing capacity in the State to satisfy
3 local demands. Due to a shortage of facilities across the
4 State, smaller-scale ranchers and hunters compete for limited
5 processing, chilling, and holding services, resulting in the
6 loss of commercial sales opportunities and the potential
7 donation of wild game meat to agencies that serve
8 under-resourced communities.

9 The legislature further finds that axis deer, an invasive
10 species that poses a continuing threat to Hawaii's environment,
11 could provide significant quantities of meat as a protein source
12 for nonprofit food distribution services, such as the State's
13 network of food banks and Feed My Sheep, Inc. of Maui County.
14 However, there is a gap between the hunters, retailers, and
15 nonprofit services because the meat requires processing prior to
16 distribution. For meat donation, other states such as Wisconsin
17 and Michigan offer models that Hawaii can assess to develop



1 processes for plan implementation and program funding, including
2 licensing fees and other funding sources managed by wildlife
3 agencies or nonprofits.

4 The purpose of this Act is to develop and appropriate funds
5 for the expansion of the State's meat processing and
6 distribution capacity, including a donation program, to allow
7 for meat sourced from axis deer and other wild game to be
8 processed and donated for distribution by nonprofit food
9 distribution services to under-resourced communities.

10 SECTION 2. The department of agriculture, in collaboration
11 with the Hawaii interagency council on homelessness; department
12 of land and natural resources, division of forestry and
13 wildlife; and department of health, food safety branch; and in
14 consultation with the county of Maui axis deer task force, shall
15 develop and implement a plan to expand the meat processing and
16 distribution capacity in the State to allow for meat from axis
17 deer and other wild game to be processed for distribution by
18 nonprofit food distribution services; provided that distribution
19 of meat under the plan shall commence no later than July 1,
20 2024.



1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5 2024-2025 for the development and implementation of a plan to
6 expand the meat processing and distribution capacity in the
7 State pursuant to this Act.

8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
9 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
