A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
SIXTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
3 general obligation reimbursable bonds in the sum of \$70,000,000
4 or so much thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year
6 2023-2024 for the purpose of the following capital improvement
7 project:

8 Lahaina bypass road, Maui

9 Plans, land acquisition, design,
10 construction, and equipment for an
11 extension of the Lahaina bypass
12 road from North Keawe street to
13 beyond Puukoolii road.

10 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024
12 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the sixth
13 senatorial district, as follows:

4 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024
6 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the sixth
7 senatorial district, as follows:

8 1. State-owned land in Kihei, Maui

9 A. Plans, design, and construction
10 for rock wall repairs and storm
11 mitigation for the state-owned
12 historic parcel at TMK 3-9-001-
13 012-0000.

1 expended by the department of land and natural resources for the
2 purposes of this part.

3 PART IV

4 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of federal moneys
5 received by the State of Hawaii the sum of \$10,000,000 or so
6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 for
7 plans, design, construction, and equipment for an R-1 water
8 reservoir.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the clean water
10 branch of the department of health for the purposes of this
11 part.

12 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general
13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,500,000 or so much
14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 for plans,
15 design, construction, and equipment for an R-1 water reservoir.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the clean water
17 branch of the department of health for the purposes of this
18 part; provided that no moneys appropriated by this section shall
19 be expended unless the county of Maui provides matching moneys
20 on a dollar-for-dollar basis.



1 SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$900,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 for the
4 construction of fencing for axis deer mitigation.

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the clean water
6 branch of the department of health for the purposes of this
7 part.

8 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of federal moneys
9 received by the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000 or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 for the
11 rehabilitation of Kulanihakoi stream, including installation of
12 irrigation from the R-1 water reservoir and planting of
13 vegetation to trap sediment.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the clean water
15 branch of the department of health for the purposes of this
16 part.

17 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of federal moneys
18 received by the State of Hawaii the sum of \$130,000 or so much
19 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 for the
20 rehabilitation of Waipulani stream, including installation of



1 irrigation from the R-1 water reservoir and planting of
2 vegetation to trap sediment.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the clean water
4 branch of the department of health for the purposes of this
5 part.


6 PART V

7 SECTION 12. The appropriations made by this Act shall not
8 lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation
9 is made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
10 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

11 SECTION 13. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
