A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
ELEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2 for capital improvement projects in the eleventh senatorial
3 district.

4 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
5 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$56,088,000 or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024
8 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
9 the eleventh senatorial district, as follows:

10 To be expended by the department of education:

11 1. Hokulani elementary school

1 SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this Act shall not
2 lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for which the
3 appropriation is made; provided that all moneys from the
4 appropriation unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as
5 of that date.

6 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital improvement projects set forth in section 2 shall be
8 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of
9 this Act.

10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
