# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Act 119, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, is  
2 amended by amending section 13 to read as follows:

3           "SECTION 13. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021[+  
4 ~~provided that section 2 shall be repealed on July 1, 2027~~]."

5           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
6 and stricken.

7           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.



**Report Title:**

Emergency Medical Responders; Emergency Ambulance Service  
Personnel; Licensure; Hawaii Medical Board

**Description:**

Repeals the sunset date of section 2 of Act 119, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, making permanent the requirement that the Hawaii Medical Board issue licenses in four levels of emergency response practice in counties with a population of five hundred thousand or greater and the creation of an additional licensure category for emergency medical technicians 1 who are certified at a higher practice level than emergency medical technicians but do not provide ambulance services. Effective 7/1/2050.
