A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that education is the
2 gateway to opportunity. Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
3 wrote on the purpose of education, "The function of education is
4 to teach one to think intensively and to think critically.
5 Intelligence plus character - that is the true goal of
6 education". Education enables Hawaii's children to develop
7 skills essential for life, learn social norms, develop judgment
8 and reasoning, and discern right from wrong. The legislature
9 recognizes that, due to the importance of education, it is
10 incumbent upon current generations to adequately fund the
11 department of education to continue and fulfill its commitment
12 to developing the academic achievement, character, and social-
13 emotional wellbeing of Hawaii's students to their full
14 potential.

15 The legislature further finds that the proposed budget
16 request will be used to maintain the operations of the public
17 school system, promote health and safety, and advance the



1 educational services provided by the department of education to
2 address the academic, social, emotional, behavioral, and
3 physical needs of Hawaii's students. To achieve this goal, the
4 department of education has identified high-leverage initiatives
5 that will accelerate and move the department of education
6 forward into the future and provide the best support for
7 students. These strategies include: supporting vulnerable
8 populations; ensuring students are workforce ready;
9 strengthening secondary math supports; providing leadership
10 development opportunities; aligning kindergarten to high school
11 curriculum; supporting middle-level education; and bolstering
12 teacher recruitment.

13 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
14 to the department of education to support wide-ranging
15 initiatives for student success.

16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$288,756,730 or so
18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
19 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
20 year 2024-2025 which shall be expended as follows:

21 (1) Fiscal year 2023-2024:

- 1 (A) \$43,571,179 for EDN 100 School-Based Budgeting;
- 2 (B) \$26,453,529 for EDN 150 Special Education and
- 3 Student Support Services;
- 4 (C) \$14,938,255 for EDN 200 Instructional Support;
- 5 (D) \$3,006,437 for EDN 300 State Administration; and
- 6 (E) \$43,064,952 for EDN 400 School Support.

7 (2) Fiscal year 2024-2025:

- 8 (A) \$53,917,722 for EDN 100 School-Based Budgeting;
- 9 (B) \$24,764,241 for Special Education and Student
- 10 Services;
- 11 (C) \$41,574,905 for EDN 200 Instructional Support;
- 12 (D) \$3,022,437 for EDN 300 State Administration; and
- 13 (E) \$34,443,073 for EDN 400 School Support.

14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
15 of education for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
