
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE CAPITOL TOURS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§27- State capitol tours program. There is
5 established within the office of the governor a state capitol
6 tours program that shall include in-person and self-guided
7 walking tours and virtual tours of the Hawaii state capitol
8 building; provided that:

9 (1) Paper brochures and information about the virtual tour
10 website shall be made available to the public in the
11 office of the governor; and

12 (2) Administration of virtual tours of the capitol shall
13 include regular maintenance and updating of a virtual
14 tour website."

15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and



1 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
2 year 2024-2025 for:

3 (1) The establishment of two full-time equivalent
4 (2.0 FTE) positions within the office of the governor
5 to provide capitol tours pursuant to section 27- ,
6 Hawaii Revised Statutes; provided that the
7 qualifications for one of the positions shall be
8 fluency in the Hawaiian language;

9 (2) The procurement, cleaning, operation, and maintenance
10 of individual audio systems for self-guided tours; and

11 (3) The production of tour materials and signage available
12 in English and non-English languages.

13 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of
14 the governor for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
