# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,  
AND TOURISM.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 201-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "§201-2 General objective, functions, and duties of  
4 department. (a) It shall be the objective of the department of  
5 business, economic development, and tourism to make broad policy  
6 determinations with respect to economic development in the State  
7 and to stimulate through research and demonstration projects  
8 those industrial and economic development efforts that offer the  
9 most immediate promise of expanding the economy of the State.  
10 The department shall endeavor to gain an understanding of those  
11 functions and activities of other governmental agencies and of  
12 private agencies that relate to the field of economic  
13 development. It shall, at all times, encourage initiative and  
14 creative thinking in harmony with the objectives of the  
15 department.



1 (b) The department of business, economic development, and  
2 tourism shall have jurisdiction over state planning under  
3 chapter 225M and the Hawaii State Planning Act under chapter  
4 226. Due to the inherently interdependent functions of  
5 development, planning, and land use, these functions shall not  
6 be transferred by executive order, directive, or memorandum, to  
7 any other department, nor shall these functions be subject to  
8 review or approval by any other department.

9 (c) The department of business, economic development, and  
10 tourism may acquire or contract to acquire by grant or purchase  
11 real, personal, or mixed property or any interest therein; to  
12 clear, improve, and rehabilitate and to sell, assign, exchange,  
13 transfer, convey, lease, or otherwise dispose of or encumber the  
14 same; and acquire property by condemnation pursuant to chapter  
15 101."

16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on March 22, 2075.
